

WHO IS THE MTA?

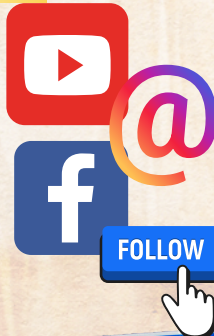

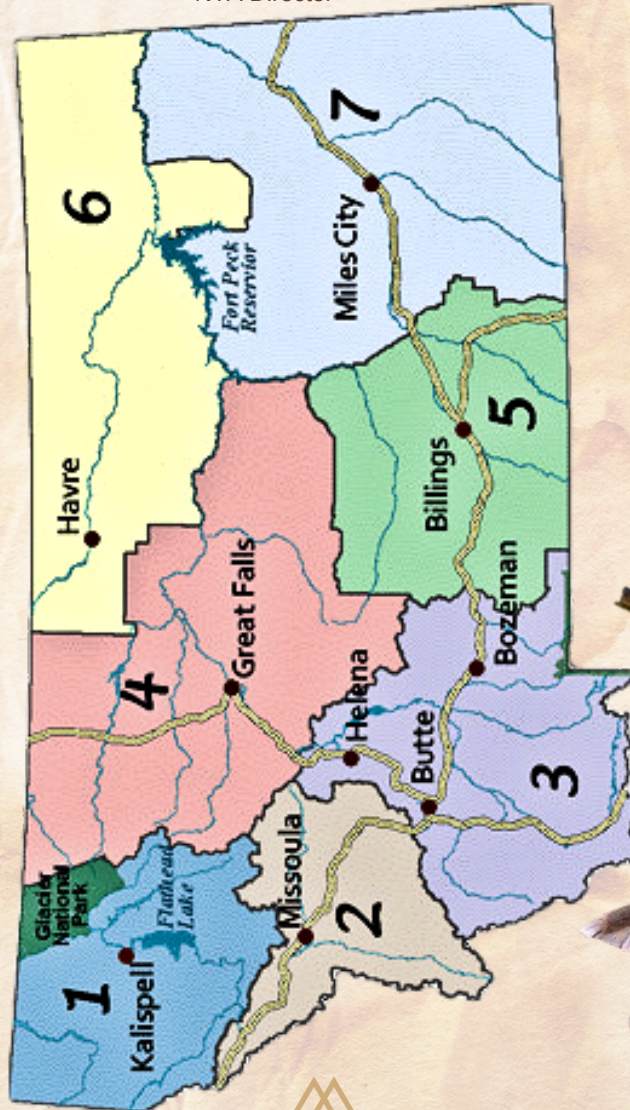


MTA DISTRICTS

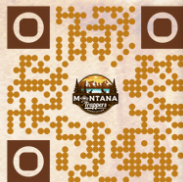
